The ABA Afghan Legal Professionals Scholarship and Mentoring Pilot Program seeks to provide housing and living expense stipends to Afghan judges, prosecutors, and lawyers while they pursue a **Master of Laws (LLM)** degree. International LLM programs are specifically designed for professionals who hold a first degree in law from a foreign university so they may sit for a bar exam and pursue career opportunities in the U.S. legal system.
